At **Camp Playland**, our staff is the key to a successful summer. We spend many hours selecting staff members who are mature, dedicated individuals and who exhibit a true desire to work with children. Combining quality staff, with directors/owners who are on site for the entire summer, sets Camp Playland far above other summer programs.

THINGS TO KNOW:

CAMP DATES - Your summer begins with Orientation on Saturday, June 14, 2008. The summer continues with the first day of camp on Monday, June 23rd, and runs daily, Monday through Friday for 8-weeks, ending on Friday, August 15th. Camp is closed on Thursday and Friday, July 3rd and 4th.

POSITIONS - Positions are available for group counselors, counselors in specialty areas, camp nurses, and office staff. Specialty areas include Swimming (lifeguard certification required), Sports, Music & Drama, Arts & Crafts, Archery, Nature and Ropes.

EVERY GROUP COUNSELOR MUST KNOW HOW TO SWIM - you will be actively involved in our swimming program, and should expect to be in the water daily.

DRESS CODE - Our counselors are role models for campers and will be asked to dress appropriately at Camp. Information regarding our dress code is included in the Staff Handbook given to every staff member.

HEALTH FORM -- A health form will be supplied to every employee. The State Health Department requires each staff member to submit a completed health form to us prior to the start of camp. The health form must be based upon a physical examination that occurred within 36 months of the first day of camp.

SALARY -- In all cases, salary is based upon the position you are hired to fill, your qualifications, and your year in school or your age. Additional salary is offered for bus counselors who supervise campers on their daily bus ride to and from camp. Although camp families may tip a counselor at the end of the summer, tipping is not mandatory and should not be expected.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN, as a camp counselor, is a fun and rewarding experience. Men and women never forget their summers as camp counselors. If you have patience, common sense and a sincere desire to work with children, we would like you to consider working at Camp Playland.
